INTRO TO THE PROJECT!

HOW YOU CAN GET INVOLVED:



CREATE a lesson presentation about financial literacy: presentation topics can include types of coins, saving, credit vs. debit, your creative ideas, etc.! Example below*



CONNECT with a local organization to teach at and set up a regular cadence; this is not limited to elementary school - can be middle or high school, an old age home, or some other local community that needs it



POST about the basics of financial literacy or statistics about worldwide lack of financial literacy on your FBLA chapter's instagram; raise awareness!



TEACH at your local organization, whether about financial literacy, investing, or FBLA!



DESIGN an investment simulator for older audiences, & teach middle/high schoolers about investing + the stock market with a fun simulator game, example below*



PROMOTE FBLA by creating an outreach presentation about FBLA to present to your local orgs, or sharing an FBLA outreach post on your chapter Instagrams



Invite speakers to your chapter/the local organization, hold an FBLA booth at your school, or **GET CREATIVE**!
