Maybe you placed at SLC last year and want to write about what it takes to win that event, or maybe you have experience in marketing and want to help promote NH For NH, or maybe you have a background in digital art and want to help design the newsletter. Regardless of your experience or background, there's plenty of options at NH For NH. It's time that we stop

waiting and start doing, as we begin this journey of forming the framework that will bring change to NH FBLA for years to come.

Get Involved:

Writing Articles

At the center of the NH For NH project are the articles that are going to be written for the newsletter. The project is looking for writers, regardless of experience, to assist in the crafting of content. Articles will cover everything FBLA and business-related such as highlighting the growth of a chapter, providing resources and guidance on how to succeed in an event, or articles on current business events.

As I spoke about in my introduction, one of the issues was that I never got the necessary resources and guidance to be prepared for my competitive event. By simply hosting a meeting within your chapter that does exactly that, you will be assisting NH FBLA take a step forward in terms of its competitiveness.

The final way to get involved is to get creative. I'm leaving this option open to allow you all to think of any other ways that can help grow this project. Don't be hesitant to reach out to me with anything that you may think of, as it likely will result in quite a hefty addition of points to your chapter's total.

Important Notes:

Points will be given based on chapter size. Additionally, all point totals will be calculated by me so it is not necessary for you to go through the process of filling out the form. I will also be updating all chapters on their involvement with the project on a monthly basis.

The Project Deadline is March 6th, 2023. This will be the last day in which involvement for my project will be considered towards the totals at SLC.

The award mentioned in my introduction, "NH For NH Member of the Month" for any given month will be announced in the following month's batch of articles.
